## Summary Findings of Current Nursing Home Inspection

- Under Care & Staffing the nursing home was compliant with 15 out of 16 regulations.**  
On the basis of this inspection and under current nursing home regulations, there are issues that need to be addressed as outlined below in relation to the Care and Staffing.
- Under Management the nursing home was compliant with 16 out of 16 regulations.**  
On the basis of this inspection and under current nursing home regulations, the inspection team would consider the nursing home to have a good standard of management.
- Under Physical Environment the nursing home was compliant with 11 out of 11 regulations.**  
On the basis of this inspection and under current nursing home regulations, the inspection team would consider the nursing home provides a good Physical Environment for residents.

Regulation number	10.2 Subject to article 10.3, the post of person in charge shall be full-time and the person in charge shall be a nurse with a minimum of three years appropriate post registration experience within the previous six years.
Non-Compliance	Sarah Ann McGivney is the registered nurse in charge at Newbrook 2 nursing home. She is not rostered on the current staff duty rota, or on several past duty rosters checked during the course of the inspection visit.
Required Action	It is a regulatory requirement that the post of person in charge shall be full time. The staff duty roster should record the hours worked by the nurse in charge.
