- Under Care & Staffing the nursing home was compliant with 21 out of 21 regulations.**
On the basis of this inspection and under current nursing home regulations, the inspection team would consider that the nursing home provides a good standard of Care and Staffing for residents.
- Under Management the nursing home was compliant with 26 out of 27 regulations.**
On the basis of this inspection and under current nursing home regulations, there are issues that need to be addressed as outlined below in relation to Management.
- Under Physical Environment the nursing home was compliant with 8 out of 11 regulations.**

Non-Compliance	No windows were restricted from opening fully. Consequently a confused person could make an unsupervised exit from the premises.
Regulation number	14(b)
Non-Compliance	In room 4 a commode was corroded in the front area adjacent to the seat. In room 10 two commodes were corroded.
