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## Summary Findings of Current Nursing Home Inspection

- Under Care & Staffing the nursing home was compliant with 19 out of 21 regulations.**  
On the basis of this inspection and under current nursing home regulations, there are issues that need to be addressed as outlined below in relation to the Care and Staffing.
- Under Management the nursing home was compliant with 27 out of 27 regulations.**  
On the basis of this inspection and under current nursing home regulations, the inspection team would consider the nursing home to have a good standard of management.
- Under Physical Environment the nursing home was compliant with 7 out of 11 regulations.**  
On the basis of this inspection and under current nursing home regulations, there are issues that need to be addressed as outlined below in relation to the Physical Environment.

## Non-Compliance

Non-Compliance	Windows were not restricted from opening to a safe distance in rooms 5, 7, 8, 9, 10, and 12, 12(a).
Required Action	Restrict windows to a safe distance to opening
Timescale	Immediate
Regulation number	Regulation 12(a)
Non-Compliance	In room 8 a TV was stored on a locker in a manner that was not safe.
Required Action	Store and operate all equipment in a safe way.
Timescale	Immediate
Regulation number	Regulation 12(a)
Non-Compliance	In room 8 an exposed picture hook was so placed between a door and a light switch so that there was a risk of a person tearing their hand as they searched to switch on the room light.
Required Action	Remove the picture hook.
Timescale	Immediate

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Regulation number Regulation 12(a)  
Non-Compliance In room 5 the trigger on the call bell was broken so that a residents hand could be torn while using the call bell.

Required Action Replace the trigger.

Timescale Immediate

Regulation number Regulation 11.2(i)  
Non-Compliance The over bed light in room 12/12(a) did not function

Required Action Repair the light.

Timescale Immediate

Regulation number Regulation 14(a)  
Non-Compliance In rooms 5, 11, and 12/12(a), clothes were stored in an untidy way.

Required Action Store clothes in a tidy manner

Timescale Immediate

Regulation number Regulation 14(a)  
Non-Compliance There were extensive cobwebs in room 11.

Required Action Maintain the premises in a clean and hygienic condition.

Timescale Immediate

Regulation number Regulation 14(a)  
Non-Compliance In several rooms chairs were chipped and worn and in need of repair.

Required Action Repair furniture as appropriate.

Timescale Immediate

Regulation number Regulation 14(a)  
Non-Compliance In the sluice room a corner shelf was defective and worn and in need of repair.

Required Action Repair or replace as appropriate.

Timescale Immediate

Regulation number Regulation 14(b)  
Non-Compliance There were dirty nebuliser masks in rooms 12/12(a) and room 7.

Required Action Maintain all equipment in a clean and hygienic condition

Timescale Immediate

Regulation number Regulation 14(b)  
Non-Compliance A sponge used by more than one person was stored

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	in the shower room.
Required Action	Such items are to be provided for each resident and stored appropriately.
Timescale	Immediate
Regulation number	Regulation 15(a)
Non-Compliance	There was no hot water available on tap in several bedrooms.
Required Action	Provide hot water on tap in each bedroom.
Timescale	Immediate
Regulation number	Article 19.1 (b)
Non-Compliance	The contracts for 3 persons resident in the Nursing Home for more than two months, were not present on the day of inspection
Required Action	Ensure copies of contracts for all persons resident for more than two months are kept in a safe place in the nursing home.
Timescale	Immediate
Regulation number	Article 19.1 (f) and Article 29 (b)
Non-Compliance	Within the Nursing Notes for the 3 <sup>rd</sup> may 2008 it is documented that a resident was given the prescription medications Clarithromycin and Deltacortril. There was no prescription signed and dated by a medical practitioner nor were there medical notes to confirm this medication.
Required Action	Ensure all prescriptions are signed and dated by a medical practitioner and ensure all treatment and medication prescribed by the medical practitioner of a dependent person is correctly administered and recorded.
Timescale	Immediate
