Summary Findings of Current Nursing Home Inspection

- Under Care & Staffing the nursing home was compliant with 20 out of 21 regulations.**
 On the basis of this inspection and under current nursing home regulations, there are issues that need to be addressed as outlined below in relation to the Care and Staffing.
- Under Management the nursing home was compliant with 27 out of 27 regulations.**
 On the basis of this inspection and under current nursing home inspections, the inspection team would consider the nursing home to have a good standard of management.
- Under Physical Environment the nursing home was compliant with 10 out of 11 regulations.**
 On the basis of this inspection and under current nursing home regulations, there are issues that need to be addressed as outlined below in relation to the Physical Environment.

Non-Compliance	There were two pressure relieving mattresses which were deflated.
Required Action	To inflate to the appropriate level.

Non-Compliance	The door of the sluice room was held open and unattended; consequently the room was easily accessible.
Required Action	The sluice room is only be accessible to appropriate staff
Timescale	Immediate
Regulation number	14(a)
Non-Compliance	In the sluice room the lid of the refuse bin was corroded
Required Action	Repair or replace
Timescale	Immediate

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Regulation number 14(b)
 Non-Compliance The front bar of a commode wheeled into the sluice room was corroded.
 Required Action Repair or replace
 Timescale Immediate

Regulation number 14(b)
 Non-Compliance In the sluice room, two used catheter bags were left in the sink. There was no indication of ownership.
 Required Action Follow manufacturers instructions or dispose of them.
 Timescale Immediate

Regulation number 14(b)
 Non-Compliance In the shower room, one used catheter bag was left in the shower tray. There was no indication of ownership.
 Required Action Follow manufacturers instructions or dispose of it.
 Timescale Immediate

Regulation number 14(b)
 Non-Compliance In room 2 a small syringe (without a needle) was stored in a cup with a tooth brush.
 Required Action Syringes must only be stored sealed then used once.
 Timescale Immediate

Regulation number 14(b)
 Non-Compliance There was a 50ml syringe in an open packet on the draining board in the sluice room. There was also a box of enteral feeding supplies on the draining board
 Required Action **Remove and dispose of syringe and store supplies in an appropriate store.**
 Timescale Immediate

Regulation number 19.1(d)
 Non-Compliance **Nursing assessments and records are not all up to date.**
 Required Action **New assessments to be carried out and documented.**
 Timescale Immediate
