Inspection Report

Re: Inspection of Cherrygrove Nursing Home, Campile, Co. Wexford under the Health (Nursing Homes) Act, 1990 and the Nursing Homes (Care & Welfare) Regulations, 1993.

Dear Sir,

The Nursing Homes Inspection Team visited Cherrygrove Nursing Home on the 27th November 2006.

There were 35 residents in the Nursing Home on this date. The Nursing Home is currently registered for 43 residents.

The following issues require your attention and action.

Article 7.2

The registered proprietor or person in charge shall execute a contract with a dependent person and/or a person acting on his or her behalf within two months of the admission of that dependent person to the nursing home.

Breach:

There are 10 Contracts of Care outstanding.

Required Action:

All contracts should be executed.

Timescale:

Immediate.

Articles 14(b):

The registered proprietor and the person in charge of the nursing home shall:

(b) make adequate arrangements for the prevention of infection, infestation, toxic conditions, or spread of infection and infestation at the nursing home;

Breach:

There was a dirty nebuliser mask attached to an oxygen cylinder in room 17.

Required Action:

The mask should be cleaned by appropriate methods as per best practice and replaced at appropriate intervals.

Timescale:

Immediate

The Chairperson of the Inspection Team is to be notified in writing indicating the steps taken by the nursing home to carry out the actions as required under the regulations.
