The following breach of the Nursing Homes (Care and Welfare) Regulations, 1993, and Nursing Homes (Care and Welfare) (Amendment) Regulations, 1994, were noted:

Article:

Regulation 11.2 states: In every nursing home there shall be provided suitable and sufficient accommodation which meets the minimum standards as follows: -

(i) over-bed lamps at each bed accessible to the person and permanent night lighting with dimming facilities.

Breach:

• Overbed light in Room 1 was not working.

Required Action:

• Repair of overbed light in Room 1.

Timescale:

• One week

Recommendations :

- Dates to be included on Documented Consent of Restraints Records.
- Recreation / Activities to be put in place daily as discussed.
- Service history to be included on the register of equipment.
- Complaints Policy to be displayed.

The Inspection Team is to be notified on or before the above date indicating the steps taken by the home to carry out the actions as required under the regulations.
