Comments and recommendations made by the inspection team as a result of the inspection	<p>In the interests of continuous quality assurance we make the following recommendations:</p> <p>All entries in the daily nursing records should be timed using the 24 hour clock as per <i>Recording Clinical Practice Guidelines</i> (An board Altranais 2002).</p> <p>Restraint consent forms should be reviewed within the specified time frame.</p> <p>The medication prescribing sheet should include a column for the signature of the transcribing nurse. The medication policy should be amended accordingly (An Board Altranais 2007).</p> <p>Provide evidence of a three monthly medication review for each resident in line with National Standards (HIQA 2008).</p> <p>Document the temperature of the medication fridge.</p> <p>Implement measures to enhance infection control as discussed.</p>	Recommendations
