Regulation 17 states that in every nursing home the following particulars shall be kept in a safe place in respect of each dependent person.

(h) a record of any occasion on which physical or chemical restraint is used, the nature of the restraint and its duration.

Breach:

■ The use of cot sides was not documented for some residents.

Required Action:

• The use of all restraints in the home to be documented.

Timescale:

• One month.

Staffing Records:

Regulation 21 states that in every nursing home there shall be kept in a safe place a record of:

(b) details of the qualifications and a copy of the certificate of current registration of each member of the nursing staff employed:

Breach:

Pin number for one nurse on the roster was not available for inspection

Required Action:

Current pin number to be faxed to the inspection team.

Timescale:

One month.

Recommendations:

Drug prescriptions to be updated as discussed with the person in charge.

The equipment list to include service history.

Outcomes of all Incidents/accidents to be recorded in the accident book.

The falls prevention policy to include clinical details.

The inspection Team is to be notified on or before the above date(s) indicating the steps taken by the home to carry out the actions as required under the regulations.
