## **Integrated Inspection Report**

**Re: Inspection of the Glenbervie Nursing Home under the Health (Nursing Homes) Act, 1990 and the Nursing Homes (Care & Welfare) Regulations 1993**

Dear Mr. & Mrs. Gillooly,

The Nursing Homes Inspection Team from an EHO/Medical /Nursing perspective inspected the Glenbervie Nursing Home, Sidmonton Road, Bray, Co. Wicklow on 20.06.2007.

The inspection commenced at 10.12a.m. and was completed by 14.15p.m. This inspection was unannounced.

There were 34 residents on this date. The Nursing Home is currently registered for 37 residents.

**Issues identified in previous Inspection Report date 11<sup>th</sup> December 2006 have been satisfactorily addressed.**

### **Current Inspection**

The following non-compliances were noted:-

#### **MEDICAL PREPARATIONS:**

*Regulation 29 states:*

*The registered proprietor and the person in charge of the nursing home shall:*

*(b) ensure that the treatment and medication prescribed by the medical practitioner of a dependent person is correctly administered and recorded.*

**Non-compliance:** Medication prescribed by Medical practitioner not recorded as administered for 2 residents.

**Required Action:** All medicines to be administered as prescribed and recorded.

**Timescale:** Immediate

**Recommendations:** Systems for the administration and recording of medicines prescribed to be put in place in accordance with An Bord Altranais guidelines on the administration of medications.

**REGISTER AND RECORDS:**

*Regulation 19.1. states:*

*In every nursing home the following particulars shall be kept in a safe place in respect of each dependent person:*

*(h) a record of any occasion on which physical or chemical restraint is used, the nature of the restraint and its duration;*

**Non-compliance:** Restraint documentation for 2 residents did not state the nature of the restraint.

**Required Action:** Restraint records must state the nature of restraint in use.

**Timescale:** Immediate

**Recommendation:** Records of use of restraints to include date, type, duration, G.P. authorisation/signature, consent of next of kin and witness signature.

The Nursing Home Inspection Team is to be notified in writing on or before the above dates indicating the steps taken by the Nursing Home to carry out the actions as required under the Regulations.
