Inspection Report

Re: Inspection of San Remo Nursing Home under the health (Nursing Homes) Act, 1990 and the Nursing Homes (Care and Welfare) Regulations, 1993.

Dear Sir/Madam,

The Health Service Executive Nursing Homes Inspection Team inspected San Remo Nursing Home, 14/15 Sidmonton Road, Bray, Co. Wicklow from 9:00am to 1:00pm on 12/01/2007.

There were 49 residents on this date. The Nursing Home is currently fully registered for 51 residents. Issues identified in the previous Inspection Report dated 26/06/2006 in relation to Inspection of 26/06/2006 have been satisfactorily addressed.

The following issues require your attention and action.

Article

DESIGN:

Regulation 12 states:

The registered proprietor and the person in charge of the nursing home shall:

- (a) take precautions against the risk of accidents to any dependent person in the nursing home and in the grounds of the nursing home.*

Breach(es):

Equipment including a dressing trolley with Betadine Solution was stored inappropriately in Room 10.

Required Action:

Equipment not in use for residents of Room 10 to be appropriately stored and Betadine Solution to be stored in a locked area.

Timescale:
Immediately

Recommendations

- Menu to be displayed in dining room daily
- Privacy signs to be put on the doors of shared Rooms nos. 23 and 24 as discussed.

Inspection Team to be notified in writing on or before the above dates of the steps taken by the nursing home to carry out the actions as required under the regulations.

We recommend re-registration of the San Remo Nursing Home for 51 residents.
