

Ambulance Officer (Aero Medical Liaison, including Special Operations) - Grade Code 6122

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 22 of the Health Act 2004, I hereby approve the qualifications, as set out hereunder, for the appointment and continuing as **Ambulance Officer (Aero Medical Liaison (including Special Operations).**

1. Professional Qualifications, Experience, etc

- (a) Candidates must,
 - (i) Be the holder of a full unendorsed Class C1 and full unendorsed class D1 driving licence;

and;

(ii) Be currently registered on, and maintain registration on the Paramedic Division of the Register as held by the Pre Hospital Emergency Care Council;

and:

(iii) Have a minimum of 2 years experience in an ambulance supervisory post;

and;

(b) Candidates must possess the requisite knowledge and ability, including a high standard of suitability and managerial ability, for the proper discharge of the duties of the office.

2. <u>Age</u>

Age restriction shall only apply to a candidate where s/he is not classified as a new entrant (within the meaning of the Public Service Superannuation (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act, 2004). A candidate who is not classified as a new entrant must be under 65 years of age on the first day of the month in which the latest date for receiving completed application forms for the office occurs.

3. Health

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be fully competent and capable of undertaking the duties attached to the office and be in a state of health such as would indicate a reasonable prospect of ability to render regular and efficient service.

4. Character

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be of good character.
