In exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 22 of the Health Act 2004, I hereby approve the qualifications, as set out hereunder, for the appointment and continuing as **Ambulance Officer in the relevant specialist area.**

**1. Professional Qualifications, Experience, etc**

- (a) Candidates must,
- (i) Be currently employed within the National Ambulance Service.  
**and;**
  - (ii) Be currently registered on, and maintain registration on the Paramedic Division of the Register as held by the Pre Hospital Emergency Care Council.  
**and;**
  - (iii) Possess the National Qualification in Emergency Medical Technology and the PHECC Paramedic Practitioner's Licence  
**and;**
  - (iv) Be the holder of a full unendorsed Class **C1** and full unendorsed class **D1** driving licence.  
**and;**
- (b) Candidates must have a minimum of two years experience in a first line ambulance management post.  
**and;**
- (c) Candidates must possess the requisite knowledge and ability, including a high standard of suitability and managerial ability, for the proper discharge of the duties of the office.

**2. Age**

Age restriction shall only apply to a candidate where s/he is not classified as a new entrant (within the meaning of the Public Service Superannuation (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act, 2004). A candidate who is not classified as a new entrant must be under 65 years of age on the first day of the month in which the latest date for receiving completed application forms for the office occurs.

**3. Health**

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be fully competent and capable of undertaking the duties attached to the office and be in a state of health such as would indicate a reasonable prospect of ability to render regular and efficient service.

**4. Character**

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be of good character.

**NOTE:**

The eligibility criteria as outlined in this document solely apply to the filling of these particular posts as part of a confined competition run by the National Recruitment Service in November 2011.
