

# Public Health Specialist (Medicine) Grade Code 1317

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 22 of the Health Act 2004, I hereby approve the qualifications, as set out hereunder, for the appointment and continuing as **Public Health Specialist (Medicine)** in the Health Service Executive.

#### 1. Statutory Registration, Professional Qualifications, Experience, etc

- (a) Eligible applicants will be those who on the date of application for the competition.
  - (i) Are registered as a Specialist in the Specialist Division of the Register of Medical Practitioners maintained by the Medical Council of Ireland in the speciality of Public Health Medicine (See Note 1\*).

#### And

(ii) Possess a high standard of professional attainment.

#### And

- (b) Candidates must possess the requisite knowledge and ability, including a high standard of suitability, management, leadership and professional ability), for the proper discharge of the duties of the office.
- Note 1\*: Applicants who are not yet registered, shall be deemed eligible under 1(a) (i) if they can achieve registration as a Specialist in the Specialist Division of the Register of Medical Practitioners maintained by the Medical Council of Ireland in the speciality of Public Health Medicine within 180 days of the date of interview.

The successful interviewee must be registered as a Specialist in the Specialist Division of the Register of Medical Practitioners maintained by the Medical Council of Ireland in the speciality of Public Health Medicine

before taking up appointment.

The candidate will be allowed a maximum of 180 calendar days from date of interview to secure this registration. Should the successful candidate not be registered as a Specialist at that time, the post may be offered to the next suitable candidate.

## 2. Entry to Competition & Subsequent Appointment:

For the purposes of eligibility for entry to any competition or recruitment process associated with this post, a candidate must fulfil the eligibility requirements laid down in the information pack for this post.

## 3. Annual registration

Practitioners must maintain annual registration as a Specialist in the Specialist Division of the Register of Medical Practitioners maintained by the Medical Council of Ireland in the speciality of Public Health Medicine.

# 4. <u>Age</u>

Age restriction shall only apply to a candidate where s/he is not classified as a new entrant (within the meaning of the Public Service Superannuation (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act, 2004). A candidate who is not classified as a new entrant must be under 65 years of age on the first day of the month in which the latest date for receiving completed application forms for the office occurs.

#### 5. Health

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be fully competent and capable of undertaking the duties attached to the office and be in a state of health such as would indicate a reasonable prospect of ability to render regular and efficient service.

#### 6. Character

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be of good character.
