

#### Senior Area Medical Officer

Grade Code - 1325

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 18 of the Health Act 1970, I hereby approve qualifications as set out hereunder for appointment and continuing as **Senior Area Medical Officer** under a Health Board.

# 1. Professional Qualifications, Experience, etc

- (i) Each candidate must, on the latest date for receiving completed application forms for the post:-
  - (a) possess full registration in the General Register of Medical Practitioners or entitlement to be so registered;
  - (b) have had, after primary medical qualification, at least, five years satisfactory experience in the practice of the medical profession;
  - (c) possess a recognised Degree or Diploma in Public Health, or equivalent

<u>or</u>

possess Membership or Fellowship of the Faculty of Public Health Medicine of the Royal College of Physicians of Ireland or a qualification at least equivalent to either of these;

and

- (d) have had adequate practical experience of Health Services.
- (ii) Each candidate must possess a satisfactory standard of:
  - (a) professional attainment in relation to Health Services

### and

- (b) administrative capacity
- (iii) Each candidate must possess the requisite knowledge and ability (including a high standard of suitability) for the proper discharge of the duties of the post.

### 2. Age

Age restriction shall only apply to a candidate where he/she is not classified as a new entrant (within the meaning of the Public Service Superannuation (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act, 2004). A candidate who is not classified as a new entrant must be under 65 years of age on the first day of the month in which the latest date for receiving completed application forms for the office occurs.

## 3. Health

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be fully competent and capable of undertaking the duties attached to the office and be in a state of health such as would indicate a reasonable prospect of ability to render regular and efficient service.

## 4. Character

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be of good character.
