

Principal Biochemist – Grade Code 3778

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 22 of the Health Act 2004, I herby approve the qualifications, as set out hereunder, for the appointment and continuing as **Principal Biochemist**

1. Professional Qualifications, Experience, etc

Candidates must

- a) have obtained, after examination or on a thesis, dissertation or published work, the MSc Degree of a recognised university in biochemistry or physiological chemistry or a qualification at least equivalent thereto
- b) have at least five years satisfactory experience in the procedures of clinical biochemistry and/or chemical pathology in the laboratory of a hospital or allied institution
- c) possess a high standard of professional attainment
- d) possess the requisite knowledge and ability (including a high standard of suitability and management ability) for the proper discharge of the duties of the office.

2. <u>Age</u>

Age restriction shall only apply to a candidate where he/she is not classified as a new entrant (within the meaning of the Public Service Superannuation (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act, 2004). A candidate who is not classified as a new entrant must be under 65 years of age on the first day of the month in which the latest date for receiving completed application forms for the office occurs.

3. Health

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be fully competent and capable of undertaking the duties attached to the office and be in a state of health such as would indicate a reasonable prospect of ability to render regular and efficient service.

4. <u>Character</u> Candidates for and any person holding the office must be of good character.
