

# Maintenance Craftsman/Technician (Carpenter) (Grade Code 5606)

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 22 of the Health Act 2004, I hereby approve the qualifications, as set out hereunder, for the appointment and continuing as a **Maintenance Craftsman/Technician (Carpenter)** in the HSE.

## 1. Professional Qualifications, Experience, etc

- (a) Eligible applicants will be those who on the closing date for the competition:
  - (i) Possess a Quality and Qualifications Ireland (QQI) Level 6 (or higher) Advanced Certificate Craft Carpentry & Joinery (or equivalent qualification).

Or

(ii) Possess the National Craft Certificate issued by FETAC

Or

(iii) Possess the Senior Trades Certificate issued by Department of Education.

Or

(iv) Possess a Level 3 Technical/Trade qualification or equivalent issued by City & Guilds, London.

#### And

(b) Candidates must possess the requisite technical knowledge and ability, including a high standard of suitability for the proper discharge of the office.

## 2. <u>Age</u>

Age restriction shall only apply to a candidate where s/he is not classified as a new entrant (within the meaning of the Public Service Superannuation (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act, 2004). A candidate who is not classified as a new entrant must be under 65 years of age on the first day of the month in which the latest date for receiving completed application forms for the office occurs.

### 3. Health

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be fully competent and capable of undertaking the duties attached to the office and be in a state of health such as would indicate a reasonable prospect of ability to render regular and efficient service.

## 4. Character

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be of good character.
