

Report of the Expert Group on Cooks 2000

Executive Chef

1. Professional Qualifications, Experience, etc

Candidates must, on the latest date for receiving completed applications for the post:

- a) be of good character
- b) be in a state of health such as would indicate a reasonable prospect of ability to render regular and efficient service
- c) have obtained the **London City & Guilds Examination No. 706/1 & No. 706/2/NCCB** or such equivalent qualifications as may be approved by the Minister for Health from time to time
- d) have at least five years satisfactory experience in cooking for an institution or other establishment, catering for a large number of persons, at supervisory/senior level
- e) experience in the operation of a Cook-Chill System would be desirable, where appropriate

2. Age

Age restriction shall only apply to a candidate where he/she is not classified as a new entrant (within the meaning of the Public Service Superannuation (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act, 2004). A candidate who is not classified as a new entrant must be under 65 years of age on the first day of the month in which the latest date for receiving completed application forms for the office occurs.

3. Health

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be fully competent and capable of undertaking the duties attached to the office and be in a state of health such as would indicate a reasonable prospect of ability to render regular and efficient service.

4. Character

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be of good character.
