

## Clinical Paramedical Supervisor Grade Code 6120

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 22 of the Health Act 2004, I hereby approve the qualifications, as set out hereunder, for the appointment and continuing as **Clinical Paramedical Supervisor** in the Health Service Executive.

## 1. Statutory Registration, Professional Qualifications, Experience, etc

(a) Eligible applicants will be those who on the closing date for the competition:

(i)	Be registered in the Advanced Paramedic Division of the live register maintained by the Pre Hospital Emergency Care Council.
	And
(ii)	Candidates must possess a minimum of 3 years post Advanced Paramedic Registration practice .
	And
(iii)	Have successfully completed the PHECC Tutor Programme or PHECC Assistant Tutor Programme
	And
(iv)	Have a full unendorsed Class C1 License (Note: Irish 78 Restriction is not acceptable)

NOTE:

Appointment to and continuation in posts that require statutory registration is dependent upon the post holder maintaining annual registration in the relevant division of the register maintained by the Pre Hospital Emergency Care Council.

### And

(b) Candidates must possess the requisite knowledge and ability, including a high standard of suitability for the proper discharge of the duties of the office.

# 2. Health

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be fully competent and capable of undertaking the duties attached to the office and be in a state of health such as would indicate a reasonable prospect of ability to render regular and efficient service.

### 3. Character

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be of good character.
