

Clinical Paramedical Supervisor Grade Code 6120

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 22 of the Health Act 2004, I hereby approve the qualifications, as set out hereunder, for the appointment and continuing as **Clinical Paramedical Supervisor** in the Health Service Executive.

1. Statutory Registration, Professional Qualifications, Experience, etc

(a) Eligible applicants will be those who on the closing date for the competition:

(i)	Are currently registered, and maintain registration on a Specialist Paramedic Division of the Register as held by the Pre Hospital Emergency Care Council
	OR
(ii)	Hold an equivalent qualification as validated by PHECC
	AND
(iii)	Hold a Paramedic educational award at QQI Level 9 or equivalent
	AND
(iv)	Candidates must have evidence of clinical instructional & supervisory practice to fulfil the functions of the role.
	AND
(v)	Have a minimum of 3 years' satisfactory service with the National Ambulance Service as a Specialist Paramedic
	AND
(vi)	Have a full Class C1 License

NOTE:

Appointment to and continuation in posts that require statutory registration is dependent upon the post holder maintaining annual registration in the relevant division of the register maintained by the Pre Hospital Emergency Care Council.

And

(b) Candidates must possess the requisite knowledge and ability, including a high standard of suitability for the proper discharge of the duties of the office.

2. Health

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be fully competent and capable of undertaking the duties attached to the office and be in a state of health such as would indicate a reasonable prospect of ability to render regular and efficient service.

3. Character

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be of good character.
