



Clinical Nurse Manager 2 - Health Protection/Public Health

(Grade Code: 2119)

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 22 of the Health Act 2004, I hereby approve the qualifications, as set out hereunder, for the appointment and continuing as **Clinical Nurse Manager 2 - Health Protection/Public Health** in the Health Service Executive.

1. Statutory Registration, Professional Qualifications, Experience, etc

(a) Eligible applicants will be those who on the closing date for the competition:

(i)	Are registered in the General Division or other divisions as relevant to the specific role, of the Register of Nurses maintained by the Nursing & Midwifery Board of Ireland (Bord Altranais agus Cnáimhseachais na hÉireann) or be entitled to be so registered.
AND	
(ii)	Have at least 5 years post registration experience of which 2 have been in health protection, infectious diseases, infection control, or Public Health or have experience in a range of clinical settings relevant to the role.
AND	
(iii)	Candidates must demonstrate evidence of continuous professional development.

And

(b) Candidates must possess the requisite knowledge and ability, including a high standard of suitability and clinical, managerial and administrative capacity to properly discharge the functions of the role.

2. Annual registration

(i)	On appointment, Practitioners must maintain live annual registration in the General Division or other divisions as relevant to the specific role, of the Register of Nurses and Midwives maintained by the Nursing and Midwifery Board of Ireland (Bord Altranais agus Cnáimhseachais na hÉireann).
And	
(ii)	Practitioners must confirm annual registration with NMBI to the HSE by way of the annual Patient Safety Assurance Certificate (PSAC).

3. Health

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be fully competent and capable of undertaking the duties attached to the office and be in a state of health such as would indicate a reasonable prospect of ability to render regular and efficient service.

4. Character

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be of good character.
