#### General Dental Surgeon

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 18 of the Health Act 1970, I hereby approve qualifications as set out hereunder for appointment and continuing as General Dental Surgeon under a Health Board.

# 1. Professional Qualifications, Experience, etc

Candidates must, on the latest date for receiving completed applications for the post:

- (a) Hold a Degree, Licence or Diploma in dental surgery/dental science;
- (b) Be registered in the Register of Dentists for Ireland or be entitled to be so registered;
- (c) Have had since becoming eligible under paragraph (a) above at least one years satisfactory experience in the practice of dentistry;
- (d) Possess a high standard of professional knowledge and ability (including a high standard of suitability) for the proper discharge of the duties of the office.

#### 2. Age

Age restriction shall only apply to a candidate where he/she is not classified as a new entrant (within the meaning of the Public Service Superannuation (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act, 2004). A candidate who is not classified as a new entrant must be under 65 years of age on the first day of the month in which the latest date for receiving completed application forms for the office occurs.

## 3. Health

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be fully competent and capable of undertaking the duties attached to the office and be in a state of health such as would indicate a reasonable prospect of ability to render regular and efficient service.

### 4. Character

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be of good character.
