

# Estate Manager – Health, Safety & Infrastructural Risk Grade Code 546Y

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 22 of the Health Act 2004, I hereby approve the qualifications, as set out hereunder, for the appointment and continuing as **Estate Manager**, **Health**, **Safety & Infrastructural Risk in** the HSE.

## 1. <u>Professional Qualifications, Experience, etc</u>

- (a) Eligible applicants will be those who on the closing date for the competition:
  - (i) A QQI level 8 University Degree in Engineering, Surveying or Architecture or be a Member, Fellow or Chartered Member of the relevant Professional Association, e.g. Engineers Ireland, RIAI, or Royal Institute of Chartered Surveyors.

## Or

(ii) A QQI level 8 (or higher) major academic award, or equivalent, in Health and Safety which is accredited for Graduate Membership of the Institute of Occupational Safety and Health (IOSH).

## Or

(iii) Be an existing Health & Safety Officer with comparable and relevant responsibilities, preferably in a healthcare environment

#### And

(iv) Have at least five years satisfactory experience after obtaining the qualification or five years relevant experience in an existing post as Health & Safety Officer, preferably in a healthcare environment.

### And

(b) Candidates must possess the requisite knowledge and ability, including a high standard of suitability and management ability), for the proper discharge of the duties of the office.

## 2. <u>Age</u>

Age restriction shall only apply to a candidate where s/he is not classified as a new entrant (within the meaning of the Public Service Superannuation (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act, 2004). A candidate who is not classified as a new entrant must be under 65 years of age on the first day of the month in which the latest date for receiving completed application forms for the office occurs.

# 3. Health

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be fully competent and capable of undertaking the duties attached to the office and be in a state of health such as would indicate a reasonable prospect of ability to render regular and efficient service.

# 4. Character

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be of good character.
