

Healthcare Chaplain (Grade Code 6404)

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 22 of the Health Act 2004, I hereby approve the qualifications, as set out hereunder, for the appointment and continuing as **Healthcare Chaplain** in the HSE.

1. <u>Professional Qualifications, Experience, etc</u>

- (a) Eligible applicants will be those who on the closing date for the competition:
 - (i) Possess a Quality and Qualifications Ireland Level 8 (or higher) degree in Theology from a recognised institute.

or

(ii) Possess an equivalent qualification.

and

(iii)Have undertaken three units of Clinical Pastoral Education in an approved centre.

and

(b) Candidates must possess the requisite knowledge and ability, including a high standard of suitability), for the proper discharge of the office.

2. <u>Age</u>

Age restriction shall only apply to a candidate where s/he is not classified as a new entrant (within the meaning of the Public Service Superannuation (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act, 2004). A candidate who is not classified as a new entrant must be under 65 years of age on the first day of the month in which the latest date for receiving completed application forms for the office occurs.

3. <u>Health</u>

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be fully competent and capable of undertaking the duties attached to the office and be in a state of health such as would indicate a reasonable prospect of ability to render regular and efficient service.

4. <u>Character</u>

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be of good character.
