1. Statutory Registration, Professional Qualifications, Experience, etc.

(a) Eligible applicants will be those who on the closing date for the competition have:

(i)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• A relevant and recognised professional qualification in a Health and Social Care profession¹ and where appropriate, have statutory registration or professional registration / accreditation. <p style="text-align: center;">And</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• A minimum of five years post qualification work experience (consecutive or aggregate) within their profession which has included significant strategic management experience at Manager level or other significant leadership experience

And

(b) Candidates must possess the requisite knowledge and ability, including a high standard of suitability and management ability), for the proper discharge of the duties of the office.

2. Health

A candidate for and any person holding the office must be fully competent and capable of undertaking the duties attached to the office and be in a state of health such as would indicate a reasonable prospect of ability to render regular and efficient service

3. Character

Each candidate for and any person holding the office must be of good character.
