

# **Intermediate Care Operative**

**Grade Code 6133** 

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 22 of the Health Act 2004, I hereby approve the qualifications, as set out hereunder, for the appointment and continuing as **Intermediate Care Operative.** 

#### 1. Professional Qualifications, Experience, etc

- (a) Eligible applicants will be those who on the closing date for the competition:
  - (i) Are currently registered, and maintain registration on the Emergency Medical Technician Division of the Register as held by the Pre Hospital Emergency Care Council.

and

(ii) Possess the National Qualification in Emergency Medical Technology and the PHECC EMT Practitioner's licence.

and

(iii) Are the holders of a current full unendorsed Class C1 and full unendorsed Class D1 driving licence – (Note UK 101 Restriction, NI 79 (NFHR) Restriction & Irish 78 Restriction is not acceptable).

and

(b) Candidates must possess the requisite knowledge and ability, (including a high standard of suitability) for the proper discharge of the duties of the office.

## 2. <u>Age</u>

Age restriction shall only apply to a candidate where s/he is not classified as a new entrant (within the meaning of the Public Service Superannuation (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act, 2004). A candidate who is not classified as a new entrant must be under 65 years of age on the first day of the month in which the latest date for receiving completed application forms for the office occurs.

#### 3. Health

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be fully competent and capable of undertaking the duties attached to the office and be in a state of health such as would indicate a reasonable prospect of ability to render regular and efficient service.

## 4. Character

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be of good character.
