

# Laboratory Technician, Senior (RPAL) Grade Code 3040

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 22 of the Health Act 2004, I hereby approve the qualifications, as set out hereunder, for the appointment and continuing as **Laboratory Technician**, **Senior** (**RPAL**) in the Health Service Executive.

# 1. Statutory Registration, Professional Qualifications, Experience, etc

- (a) Eligible applicants will be those who on the closing date for the competition:
  - (i) Hold a minimum of a Level 7 qualification on the National Framework of Qualifications (NFQ) maintained by the Quality and Qualifications Ireland (QQI) in which Chemistry, Food Chemistry, Microbiology or Biochemistry was a major subject or option in the final examination or hold an equivalent professional qualification.

### OR

(ii) Hold an N.C.E.A. Diploma in Science (Chemistry, Biology or Microbiology option) or equivalent qualification.

### **AND**

(iii) Have at least three years post qualification experience in a Public Analysts Laboratory or equivalent.

## **AND**

(iv) Have practical experience of analytical chemistry or microbiology, as appropriate, in the analysis of food or waters/effluents or drugs or cosmetics in a Public Analysts' laboratory or equivalent.

#### AND

(b) Candidates must possess the requisite knowledge and ability, including a high standard of suitability), for the proper discharge of the duties of the office.

## 2. Health

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be fully competent and capable of undertaking the duties attached to the office and be in a state of health such as would indicate a reasonable prospect of ability to render regular and efficient service.

# 3. Character

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be of good character.
