



**Nursing & Midwifery Services Director, Office of the Nursing & Midwifery Services Director
(ONMSD), Office of the Chief Clinical Officer (CCO), HSE**

(National Director, Assistant, Services – Grade Code 0509)

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 22 of the Health Act 2004, I hereby approve the qualifications, as set out hereunder, for the appointment and continuing as **Nursing & Midwifery Services Director, Office of the Nursing & Midwifery Services Director** in the Health Service Executive.

1. Statutory Registration, Professional Qualifications, Experience, etc

(a) Eligible applicants will be those who on the closing date for the competition:

(i) Are registered on the Nursing and/or Midwifery Divisions of the Register of Nurses and Midwives maintained by the Nursing and Midwifery Board of Ireland (NMBI) (Bord Altranais agus Cnáimhseachais na hÉireann) or be entitled to be so registered.

And

(ii) Hold a post graduate qualification at not less than level 9 (QQI) in health care management, nursing/midwifery or a related field relevant to the duties of the role

And

(iii) Provide evidence of on-going continuous professional development

And

(iv) Have a minimum of 10 years post registration nursing and/or midwifery experience, incorporating no less than 5 years senior Nursing/Midwifery management experience in the last 10 years, including a minimum of 3 years' experience at Director of Nursing/Midwifery level or higher.

And

(v) Provide evidence of participation in national level initiatives

And

(b) Candidates must possess the requisite clinical, leadership, managerial and administrative knowledge and ability for the proper discharge of the duties of the office.

2. Annual registration

(i) On appointment, practitioners must maintain live annual registration on the Nursing and/or Midwifery Divisions of the Register of Nurses and Midwives maintained by the Nursing and Midwifery Board of Ireland (NMBI) (Bord Altranais agus Cnáimhseachais na hÉireann).

And

- (ii) Practitioners must confirm annual registration with NMBI (Bord Altranais agus Cnáimhseachais na hÉireann) to the HSE by way of the annual Patient Safety Assurance Certificate (PSAC).


3. Health

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be fully competent and capable of undertaking the duties attached to the office and be in a state of health such as would indicate a reasonable prospect of ability to render regular and efficient service.

4. Character

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be of good character.
