

### **Orthoptist - Grade Code 3409**

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 22 of the Health Act 2004, I hereby approve the qualifications, as set out hereunder, for the appointment and continuing as **Orthoptist.** 

#### 1. Professional Qualifications, Experience, etc

- (a) Eligible applicants will be those who on the closing date for the competition possess.
  - (i) B.Sc (Hons) Orthoptics from Glasgow Caledonian University

or

(ii) B.Sc (Hons) Orthoptics from the University of Liverpool

or

(iii) BMed Sci (Hons) Orthoptics from the University of Sheffield.

- (iv) Candidates must possess validated qualification equivalent to (i) or (ii) or (iii) above.
- (b) Candidates must be registered as an Orthoptist with the Health & Care Professionals Council UK. (HCPC).

and

(c) Candidates must have the requisite knowledge and ability (including a high standard of suitability and management ability) for the proper discharge of the duties of the office.

# 2. <u>Age</u>

Age restriction shall only apply to a candidate where s/he is not classified as a new entrant (within the meaning of the Public Service Superannuation (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act, 2004). A candidate who is not classified as a new entrant must be under 65 years of age on the first day of the month in which the latest date for receiving completed application forms for the office occurs.

#### 3. Health

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be fully competent and capable of undertaking the duties attached to the office and be in a state of health such as would indicate a reasonable prospect of ability to render regular and efficient service.

# 4. Character

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be of good character.
