

### Senior Perfusionist - Grade Code 3057

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 22 of the Health Act 2004, I hereby approve the qualifications, as set out hereunder, for the appointment and continuing as **Senior Perfusionist**.

# 1. Professional Qualifications, Experience, etc

- (a) Candidates must:
  - (i) must be accredited by the College of Clinical Perfusion of Great Britain and Ireland; or:
  - (ii) possess an equivalent qualification;

and:

(iii) Be registered with the College of Clinical Perfusionists of Great Britain and Ireland as a practising clinical Perfusionist;

and;

- (iv) Have at least five years' post qualification experience.
- (b) Candidates must have the clinical administrative and managerial capacity to properly discharge the functions of the role

#### 2. Age

Age restriction shall only apply to a candidate where s/he is not classified as a new entrant (within the meaning of the Public Service Superannuation (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act, 2004). A candidate who is not classified as a new entrant must be under 65 years of age on the first day of the month in which the latest date for receiving completed application forms for the office occurs.

## 3. Health

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be fully competent and capable of undertaking the duties attached to the office and be in a state of health such as would indicate a reasonable prospect of ability to render regular and efficient service.

#### 4. Character

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be of good character.
