



**Pharmacist, Chief I - Primary Care Reimbursement Service (PCRS)**

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 22 of the Health Act 2004, I hereby approve the qualifications, as set out hereunder, for the appointment and continuing as **Pharmacist, Chief I - Primary Care Reimbursement Service (PCRS)** in the Health Service Executive.

**1. Professional Qualifications, Experience, etc**

(a) Eligible applicants will be those who on the closing date for the competition:

(i)	are a registered Pharmacist with the Pharmaceutical Society of Ireland (PSI) or be entitled to be so registered.
<b>AND</b>	
(ii)	Have at least five years satisfactory post registration experience.
<b>AND</b>	
(iii)	possess the requisite knowledge and ability (including a high standard of suitability and management ability) for the proper discharge of the duties of the office.

**2. Annual Registration**

On appointment, Practitioners must maintain live annual registration on the Pharmacist Register maintained by Pharmaceutical Society of Ireland.

**3. Health**

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be fully competent and capable of undertaking the duties attached to the office and be in a state of health such as would indicate a reasonable prospect of ability to render regular and efficient service.

**4. Character**

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be of good character.
