

Pharmacist, Chief II (Community Healthcare Organisation) Grade Code 3271

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 22 of the Health Act 2004, I hereby approve the qualifications, as set out hereunder, for the appointment and continuing as **Pharmacist**, **Chief II** (**Community Healthcare Organisation**) in the HSE.

1. Professional Qualifications, Experience, etc

- (a) Eligible applicants will be those who on the closing date for the competition:
 - (i) Are a registered Pharmacist with the Pharmaceutical Society of Ireland (PSI) or be entitled to be so registered.

And

(ii) Have at least five years satisfactory post registration experience across community and hospital pharmacy services.

And

(iii) Possess a high standard of administrative, managerial or business ability.

And

(b) Candidates must possess the requisite knowledge and ability (including a high standard of suitability, management, leadership and professional ability), for the proper discharge of the office.

2. Annual registration

Practitioners must maintain annual registration on the Pharmacist Register maintained by Pharmaceutical Society of Ireland.

3. <u>Age</u>

Age restriction shall only apply to a candidate where s/he is not classified as a new entrant (within the meaning of the Public Service Superannuation (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act, 2004). A candidate who is not classified as a new entrant must be under 65 years of age on the first day of the month in which the latest date for receiving completed application forms for the office occurs.

4. Health

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be fully competent and capable of undertaking the duties attached to the office and be in a state of health such as would indicate a reasonable prospect of ability to render regular and efficient service.

5. Character

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be of good character.
