In exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 22 of the Health Act 2004, I hereby approve the qualifications, as set out hereunder, for the appointment and continuing as **Pharmacist, Chief II (Community Healthcare Organisation)** in the HSE.

**1. Professional Qualifications, Experience, etc**

(a) Eligible applicants will be those who on the closing date for the competition:

(i) Are a registered Pharmacist with the Pharmaceutical Society of Ireland (PSI) or be entitled to be so registered.

**And**

(ii) Have at least five years satisfactory post registration experience across community and hospital pharmacy services.

**And**

(iii) Possess a high standard of administrative, managerial or business ability.

**And**

(b) Candidates must possess the requisite knowledge and ability (including a high standard of suitability, management, leadership and professional ability), for the proper discharge of the office.

**2. Annual registration**

Practitioners must maintain annual registration on the Pharmacist Register maintained by Pharmaceutical Society of Ireland.

**3. Age**

Age restriction shall only apply to a candidate where s/he is not classified as a new entrant (within the meaning of the Public Service Superannuation (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act, 2004). A candidate who is not classified as a new entrant must be under 65 years of age on the first day of the month in which the latest date for receiving completed application forms for the office occurs.

**4. Health**

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be fully competent and capable of undertaking the duties attached to the office and be in a state of health such as would indicate a reasonable prospect of ability to render regular and efficient service.

**5. Character**

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be of good character.
