



**Pharmacist, Chief II (Community Healthcare Organisation)
Grade Code 3271**

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 22 of the Health Act 2004, I hereby approve the qualifications, as set out hereunder, for the appointment and continuing as **Pharmacist, Chief II (Community Healthcare Organisation)** in the Health Service Executive.

1. Statutory Registration, Professional Qualifications, Experience, etc

(a) Eligible applicants will be those who on the closing date for the competition:

(i) Are a registered Pharmacist with the Pharmaceutical Society of Ireland (PSI) or be entitled to be so registered.

And

(ii) Have at least five years satisfactory post registration experience in either a community **or** a hospital environment, **or** a combination of both.

And

(iii) Possess a high standard of administrative, managerial or business ability.

And

(b) Candidates must possess the requisite knowledge and ability (including a high standard of suitability, management, leadership and professional ability), for the proper discharge of the duties of the office.

2. Annual registration

On appointment, Practitioners must maintain live annual registration on the Pharmacist Register maintained by Pharmaceutical Society of Ireland.

3. Health

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be fully competent and capable of undertaking the duties attached to the office and be in a state of health such as would indicate a reasonable prospect of ability to render regular and efficient service.

4. **Character**

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be of good character.
