

## Pharmacist, Chief II (Community Healthcare Organisation) Grade Code 3271

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 22 of the Health Act 2004, I hereby approve the qualifications, as set out hereunder, for the appointment and continuing as **Pharmacist**, **Chief II** (**Community Healthcare Organisation**) in the Health Service Executive.

# 1. Statutory Registration, Professional Qualifications, Experience, etc

- (a) Eligible applicants will be those who on the closing date for the competition:
  - (i) Are a registered Pharmacist with the Pharmaceutical Society of Ireland (PSI) or be entitled to be so registered.

#### And

(ii) Have at least five years satisfactory post registration experience in either a community **or** a hospital environment, **or** a combination of both.

## And

(iii) Possess a high standard of administrative, managerial or business ability.

## And

(b) Candidates must possess the requisite knowledge and ability (including a high standard of suitability, management, leadership and professional ability), for the proper discharge of the duties of the office.

## 2. Annual registration

On appointment, Practitioners must maintain live annual registration on the Pharmacist Register maintained by Pharmaceutical Society of Ireland.

## 3. Health

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be fully competent and capable of undertaking the duties attached to the office and be in a state of health such as would indicate a reasonable prospect of ability to render regular and efficient service.

**4.** Character Candidates for and any person holding the office must be of good character.
