

### Chiropodist/Podiatrist, Senior Grade Code 3346

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 22 of the Health Act 2004, I hereby approve the qualifications, as set out hereunder, for the appointment and continuing as **Chiropodist/Podiatrist, Senior** in the Health Service Executive.

### 1. <u>Statutory Registration, Professional Qualifications, Experience, etc</u>

(a) Eligible applicants will be those who on the closing date for the competition:

(i)	Hold the B.Sc. (Hons) in Podiatry at level 8 on the National Framework of Qualifications (NFQ) maintained by Quality and Qualifications Ireland (QQI), National University of Ireland.
Or	
(ii)	Hold the B.Sc (Hons) Podiatric Medicine at level 8 on the National Framework of Qualifications (NFQ) maintained by Quality and Qualifications Ireland (QQI), National University of Ireland
Or	
(iii)	Hold a qualification equivalent to (i) or (ii) above which has been validated by the Department of Health.
And	
(iv)	Be on the list of podiatrists/chiropodists approved by the HSE to practice in the publicly funded health service on or before 30 <sup>th</sup> April 2010.
And	
( <b>v</b> )	Have 3 years fulltime (or an aggregate of 3 years) post qualification clinical experience.

### And

(b) Candidates must possess the requisite knowledge and ability, including a high standard of suitability and professional ability), for the proper discharge of duties of the office.

# 2. <u>Health</u>

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be fully competent and capable of undertaking the duties attached to the office and be in a state of health such as would indicate a reasonable prospect of ability to render regular and efficient service.

# 3. Character

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be of good character.
