

Statistician, Principal

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 22 of the Health Act 2004, I hereby approve the qualifications, as set out hereunder, for the appointment and continuing as an **Statistician**, **Principal** in the Health Service Executive.

1. Statutory Registration, Professional Qualifications, Experience, etc.

(a) **Candidates for appointment must:**

(i)	Possess National Framework of Qualification (in Ireland) Level 9 or 10 or equivalent in a highly relevant quantitative field:
	 i. Biostatistics ii. Maths iii. Statistical epidemiology iv. Econometrics v. Health geography vi. Spatial epidemiology vii. Geospatial analysis viii. Infectious disease epidemiology ix. Other relevant subject
	AND

(ii))	Have at least 7 years workplace experience in statistical epidemiology, biostatistical analysis and/or modelling relevant to health data.
		AND
(iii)	Have at least 2 years' experience in a supervisory role.

AND (iv) Candidates must possess the requisite knowledge and ability, (including a high standard of suitability, management, leadership and professional ability) for the proper discharge of the duties of the office.

2. <u>Health</u>

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be fully competent and capable of undertaking the duties attached to the office and be in a state of health such as would indicate a reasonable prospect of ability to render regular and efficient service.

3. Character

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be of good character.
