

## Surveillance Assistant Grade Code 0558

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 22 of the Health Act 2004, I hereby approve the qualifications, as set out hereunder, for the appointment and continuing as **Surveillance Assistant** in the Health Service Executive.

## 1. Statutory Registration, Professional Qualifications, Experience, etc

(a) Eligible applicants will be those who on the closing date for the competition:

(1)	Hold an NFQ* Level 8 degree or higher, in one of the following: <ul> <li>(a) Epidemiology</li> <li>(b) Public Health</li> <li>(c) Microbiology and/or Infectious Diseases</li> <li>(d) Biological Sciences</li> <li>(e) Biomedical Sciences</li> <li>(f) Health Informatics</li> <li>(g) Other relevant health sciences subject</li> </ul> *https://nfq.qqi.ie/ AND Have at least 6 months experience providing administrative and data
	processing support in a scientific or healthcare environment.
	OR
(ii)	Have at least two years' experience providing administrative and data processing support as a Clerical Officer (or related position) at the closing date in the HSE, TUSLA, other statutory health agencies, or a body which provides services on behalf of the HSE under Section 38 of the Health Act 2004.

## AND

(b) Candidates must possess the requisite professional knowledge and ability to carry out the duties and responsibilities of the role

## 2. <u>Health</u>

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be fully competent and capable of undertaking the duties attached to the office and be in a state of health such as would indicate a reasonable prospect of ability to render regular and efficient service.

# 3. Character

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be of good character.
