

Surveillance Officer, Public Health Grade Code 3113

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 22 of the Health Act 2004, I hereby approve the qualifications, as set out hereunder, for the appointment and continuing as **Surveillance Officer**, **Public Health** in the Health Service Executive.

1. <u>Statutory Registration, Professional Qualifications, Experience, etc.</u>

(a) Eligible applicants will be those who on the closing date for the competition:

(i)	Hold a qualification on the National Framework of Qualifications (NFQ) maintained by Quality and Qualifications Ireland (QQI) at Level 8 or higher in one of the following:
	 (a) Epidemiology (b) Public Health (c) Microbiology and/or Infectious Diseases (d) Biological Sciences (e) Biomedical Sciences (f) Health Informatics (g) Other relevant health sciences subject
	AND
(ii)	Have at least 2 years' experience in a scientific or healthcare environment managing data and conducting data analysis

AND

(b) Candidates must possess the requisite professional knowledge and ability to carry out the duties and responsibilities of the role

AND

2. <u>Health</u>

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be fully competent and capable of undertaking the duties attached to the office and be in a state of health such as would indicate a reasonable prospect of ability to render regular and efficient service.

3. Character

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be of good character.
