

WHAT TO EXPECT: THE HSE RECRUITMENT JOURNEY

Successful Application

If your application was successful, the next stage is your interview

Notice of Interview

We normally give 2 weeks' notice for interview

Preparing for Interview

We will send you supporting information to help you prepare

Practicing for Interview

Practice by talking out loud about your skills and experience
Ideally you could practice with a colleague or friend

Results of Interview

After your interview you will receive your results which details the score awarded for each assessment area

Contract of Employment

Once all the paperwork is completed, you will receive a contract of employment with your agreed start date

Appointment of HSE Employee

You will be asked to supply important documents that are needed to appoint you as HSE employee within a defined timeline

Accepting the Job

If you have accepted a job the next step is the clearance and contracting stage of the recruitment process

Job Offer Process

The job offer process has deadlines in place to support the health services in filling jobs as quickly as possible

Job Offer

Candidates who are ranked highest are offered the job first

On occasion the HSE is supported in recruitment by external companies. These companies recruit HSE employees on our behalf and to our standard.
