Introduction

The Continuous Professional Development Support Scheme (CPD-SS) is funded by the HSE to facilitate NCHDs who are not on a formal training scheme to continue to maintain and enhance their clinical knowledge and skills and to maintain their professional competence in line with Medical Council requirements.

The CPD-SS has been developed with a view to providing NCHDs who are not enrolled in specialist training with professional educational/training courses and activities to assist the NCHD with fulfilling some of the requirements of their Professional Competence Scheme.

NCHDs can apply for the CPD-SS if they:

- 1) Hold NCHD Contract 2010 and work in the Irish public health service.
- 2) Are registered on the General Division or Supervised Division of the Register of Medical Practitioners maintained by the Medical Council.
- 3) Are currently enrolled in a Professional Competence Scheme as required by law.

To access the scheme in 2025/2026, NCHDs should either have registered with a Training Body until 30th September 2025 or there is a second opportunity for NCHDs to register for the scheme from 8th December 2025 until 30th January 2026. NCHDs eligible for CPD- SS should register with the relevant Training Body.

NCHDs will have access to a range of clinical courses/activities provided by all Irish Training Bodies. They will be able to participate in training and educational activities and earn a maximum of 20 external credits or 3 days per annum, whichever is greatest.
