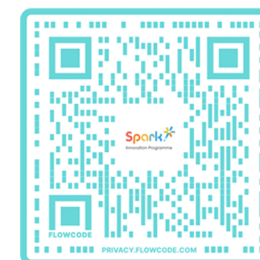
Design Thinking Workshops
