Phased Dispensing

Dear Doctor,

I refer to previous correspondence Circular 47 / 16.

Under Phased Dispensing rules the circumstances in which Phased Dispensing may be the subject of a valid claim are

- 1. At the request of a patient's physician;
- 2. Due to the inherent nature of a medicinal product i.e. product stability and shelf life;
- 3. Where a patient is commencing new drug therapy with a view to establishing patient tolerance and acceptability before continuing on a full treatment regimen;
- 4. In exceptional circumstances where the patient is incapable of safely and effectively managing the medication regimen

From 1st May 2017, functionality will be made available through the Doctor Application Suite to GPs who wish to enroll patients for phased dispensing services without writing 'Phased Dispensing' on the face of the GMS prescription. Where a GP completes the application, it will be automatically approved and contemporaneously visible to the Pharmacist through the Pharmacy Application Suite.

Where the GP has made a request to the dispensing pharmacy by writing the words 'Phased Dispensing' on the face of the GMS prescription, the pharmacy has the functionality through the Pharmacy Application Suite to select Reason 1 and upload a copy of the GP prescription displaying the doctor's instruction for phased dispensing.

Phased Dispensing must be written on the face of the prescription each month unless the GP enrols the patient through the GP application suite for ongoing phased dispensing services. If the patient is 80 and over, when enrolled through the GP application suite, such approval would then be lifelong. The GP application suite is being updated accordingly and a screen shot is attached to this communication.

You are reminded that where nursing supervision is available in a patient's residential setting, phased dispensing claims cannot be submitted for payment by the pharmacy. Some claims are presented as four separate prescriptions, each for one week's supply. It remains our position that such circumvention of the HSE's policy for nursing home patients is not acceptable.

I trust that this clarifies the matters arising with this issue and look forward to your cooperation in this regard.
