I am directed by the Minister for Health and Children to refer to the revision of remuneration for Hospital Consultants under the Review Body on Higher Remuneration in the Public Sector (Report No. 38) and to authorise payment of the pay increases contained therein, subject to the submission of appropriate costings and the agreement of same with the Department.

The findings of the Review Body, approved by the Government from 25 September 2000, provide for a 10% increase in basic pay, annual flat rate on-call allowance and emergency call-out rates. This increase should be applied as outlined in Appendix A attached. These increases are to be applied to the salaries of hospital consultants and retired hospital consultants where appropriate. Please note that the rates advised in this circular are the way increases are to be applied.

The annual limit for call-out payments is increased in line with this Report. The Review Body made a specific recommendation in relation to on-call payments for consultants on 1:1 and 1:2 rotas. Rates of increase for on-call payments to these two categories are to be increased by between 10% and 60% depending on the rota and call-out frequency.

Application of the on-call (B factor) payments where payment is based on call-outs over and above 80 or 120 per annum will require some additional administration. The normal extended duty liability allowance should be paid on an ongoing basis as is the case at present. Where entitlement is earned over and above this, i.e. in cases where the number of call-outs exceeds 80 per annum, the additional entitlement will be calculated on an annual basis and I would suggest that the calendar year be used for this purpose. However, in cases where the pattern of call-outs is well established as exceeding 80 per annum, the appropriate higher



Shaping a Healthier Future extended duty liability allowance should be paid on an ongoing basis and if the pattern subsequently changes, adjustments can be made. In a year when a consultant on a 1:1 or 1:2 rota retires, he or she should not be disadvantaged in relation to pension entitlement by virtue of the fact of not having completed a full calendar year. For application of these rates see Appendix B.

Under 4.4 of the Memorandum of Agreement of the Consultants' Contract, the terms under which emergency service payments including EPJs are made are set out. Accordingly, if a consultant qualifies for a payment under 4.4, it should be included in the calculation of the number of call-outs in a given period, in this case a calendar year.

Your financial allocation falls to be adjusted. However no adjustment will be made until detailed costings are submitted and have been agreed with the Department.

### Appendix A

### Report of Review Body on Higher Remuneration in the Public Sector (Buckley 38)

### 10% pay increase to Hospital Consultants and method of application

The 10% pay increase to consultants basic salaries is to be applied as follows:

- 1. First 5% of Buckley increase to be applied from 25 September 2000 (the date of the report);
- 2. Apply 5.5% PPF from 1/10/00.
- 3. Application of the second part of the Buckley increase (5%) is to be applied from 1<sup>st</sup> March 2001. To do this, take the figure at 1st April, 2000, increase it by 10% (as per Buckley 38 report) and then apply the 5.5% PPF increase (Oct. 00). The following is an example using this method of calculation (in IR£)

Please note that the above method of calculation is to be used only for calculation of 10 % increase to consultants' basic salary. All other Buckley and PPF increases should be applied by date in the usual manner.
