

Acting-Up Arrangements for Psychiatric Nurses

I am directed by the Minister for Health to refer to this Department's letter of 26 June 1997 concerning the special arrangements for payment in relation to Acting-Up for Psychiatric Nurses.

As indicated in that letter, the rates applicable fall to be adjusted in line with general round increases. A number of enquiries have been received in relation to the impact of the October 1996 and January 1997 General Rounds (1.5% and 1% respectively). Set out below are the revised amounts incorporating increases under the PCW.

1. Psychiatric Staff Nurse acting-up at Nursing Officer 2 should receive the following allowance or the minimum of the scale, whichever is greater.
