


Re: Health Board Dental Surgeons - DTSS - After Hours Sessional Rate

I refer to our recent discussions in respect of the above matter and wish to set out the following offer from management:

- (1) The revised sessional rate will be €189.00 per session.
- (2) This rate of pay will be effective from 1 January 2002.
- (3) The current double rate of €221.70 payable for sessions carried out on Saturdays/Sundays will cease to apply and will be replaced with this new agreed rate.
- (4) The rate will be reviewed in two years from the effective date i.e. 1 January 2004.

The revised rate will be implemented, when accepted, in full and final settlement of your claim and will not be reviewed or quoted as precedent, under any circumstances until the review date. I would be obliged if you could indicate acceptance of this offer by your members as soon as possible.
