Subject: HR Circular 007/2024 – HSE Menopause Policy

Dear Colleagues

The <u>HSE Menopause Policy</u> comes into effect from 10th April 2024. The focus of the policy is on supporting employees who are experiencing or who may, in the future, experience menopausal symptoms which impact on them at work. It aims to give guidance to managers and employees on how to be supportive of employees with menopause related concerns, with a focus on awareness and support in the workplace.

The Women's Health Taskforce was established by the Department of Health to improve women's health outcomes, and experiences of healthcare, in September 2019. Inputs from this informed the Women's Health Action Plan 2022 – 2023. As part of these recommendations state organisations were advised to develop and implement a Menopause in the Workplace Policy by the 30th June 2024. The HSE

Menopause Policy has been based on the <u>Civil Service Menopause in the Workplace</u> Policy Framework which issued in October 2023.

Two educational training modules have been developed for HSeLanD to support implementation of the policy

- an information module for all employees and
- a managers module detailing how to support employees who have symptoms impacting them at work.
