**Codes and Collection of Covid-19 absence** 

For Reference: previously issued relevant HR Circulars; HR Circular <u>007/2020</u>, HR Circular <u>008/2020</u>, HR Circular <u>018/2020</u> and HR Circular <u>038/2020</u> on COVID-19 absence/attendance codes

Dear Colleagues,

The purpose of this circular is to set out the revised arrangements in regard to the relevant COVID-19 absence/attendance **codes** for reporting, subsequent to the revised guidelines from the Department of Public Expenditure and Reform (DPER) for Public Service Employers during COVID-19 as outlined in HR Circular 005/2022 (<u>link here</u>) and HR Circular 07/2022 regarding updated Occupational Health Guidance dated 1<sup>st</sup> March 2022 (<u>link here</u>). This circular also sets out the revised arrangements for the **collection** of COVID-19 absence data.

# 1 Revised arrangements in regard to COVID-19 absence/attendance codes

In accordance with the guidance set out in HR Circular 005/2022, absence code **0403 COVID-19 SLWP** will only apply when an employee is required to self-isolate **and** is displaying symptoms of COVID-19, or had a positive PCR test / or for those under 40

who have registered a positive antigen test on the HSE portal. Medical or HSE advice should be followed. The HSE sets out the latest criteria for self-isolation at this link here.

Appropriate medical/HSE confirmation of the need to self-isolate and/or diagnosis of COVID-19 will be required for the duration of the absence. This code will continue to remain in place for use as required.

Absence/Attendance codes **0406 COVID-19 Available to work Cocoon** and **0407 COVID 19 Available to work Caring arrangements** will be made obsolete on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2022. From the 1<sup>st</sup> April 2022 these codes will no longer be available for use.

# 2 Revised arrangements for the collection of Covid-19 absence/attendance data

The below detail sets out the revised arrangements for the collection of COVID-19 absence/attendance data:

- Weekly collection of COVID-19 absence/ attendance data will continue for the month of March 2022 inclusive, from which such time it will move to fortnightly as set out below:
- The arrangements for the **fortnightly collection** of COVID-19 absence/attendance data are:
  - The deadline for the receipt of the first fortnightly COVID-19 absence/attendance data will be 12 noon on Monday 11<sup>th</sup> April, with the second and final reporting date 12 noon on Monday 25<sup>th</sup> April;
  - COVID-19 absence/attendance data due at 12 noon on Monday 11<sup>th</sup> April will relate to the fortnightly reporting period of 28<sup>th</sup> March to 10<sup>th</sup> April 2022;
  - Fortnightly COVID-19 absence/attendance data should be submitted to Email: nationalabsence@hse.ie
- From 26<sup>th</sup> April 2022 onwards, the data collection and reporting process for COVID-19 absence reporting will be that currently in place as part of the **monthly** National Health Service Absence Report;
- As a reminder, from 31<sup>st</sup> March 2022, only absence code **0403 COVID-19 SLWP** will be available for reporting COVID-19 absence reporting.
