Public Health Service Employees Unfit for Work Post-COVID-19

Infection until 31st October 2023

Dear Colleagues

I refer to the *Temporary Scheme of Paid Leave for Public Health Service Employees Unfit for Work post COVID-19 Infection* as set out in HSE HR Circular 22/2022 <u>here.</u>

I wish to advise that the Department of Public Expenditure and Reform (DPER) has conveyed sanction for an extension to this scheme from 1 July 2023 until **31 October 2023**. This four-month extension is sanctioned on a once-off basis only. The extension only applies to those employees who are currently availing of the scheme, and excludes any new applications.

The sanction is on the basis of the Second Special Extension of the scheme i.e. that the extension will provide for basic pay and fixed allowances for the period 1 July

2023 to 31 October 2023. Unsocial hours premium payments will **not** apply during this period.

Please note that the following sections of HSE HR Circular 22/2022 will continue to apply during the four-month extension:

- Section 4 Conditions of the Scheme
- Section 5 Recording and Reporting Requirements

Please ensure that this Circular is brought to the attention of managers and relevant staff within your area of responsibility. Arrangements should be made to notify the eligible employees of the four-month extension to the scheme <u>as soon as possible</u>.
