Subject: HR Circular 016/2025 - Mental Health Nursing on Call

Dear Colleagues,

Following WRC - CAM - 101540-24 - Review of Nursing on-call Mental Health Services, the following has been agreed. The rate of allowance is applicable with effect from 1st June 2024, as per the following remuneration/compensation for oncall arrangements

The Fixed Allowance rate per annum is:

Rate @ 1st June 2024	€7,717
Rate @ 1st October 2024	€7,794
Rate @ 1st March 2025	€7,950

This allowance will have a dedicated SAP wage code which should be used, to ensure those entitled receive retrospection and future increases.

# 1. Grades of Staff to Participate in on-call:

- 1. Assistant Directors of Nursing,
- 2. Directors of Nursing

Specific current arrangements for Area DONs (3 years and review 2027) and specific and current arrangements for CNM3 to be communicated locally.

# 2. Minimum & Maximum number of staff to participate in on call arrangement:

Minimum 4, or a total available number of relevant Nurse Manager Grades up to a Maximum 9.

The areas where the numbers are above 9 (as of August 2024) are red circled to the current incumbents. This number should therefore decrease to the maximum or below, over time.

### 3. On-call time

Start Time: at the end of the rostered on site Assistant Director of Nursing day shift.

<u>Finish Time:</u> at the commencement of rostered on site Assistant Director of Nursing day shift.

## 4. Time Off In Lieu

- On Call TOIL 1 day time off in lieu per 7 days on call to be taken within the on-call roster period identified. In acknowledgement of areas where time off in lieu was not previously provided, certain arrangements for the above will apply locally, based on information previously provided.
- On Site TOIL (hour for hour): Call Out sheet to include time of call out and time call ends, standard approval process apply.

## 5. Travel and Subsistence

Standard travel and subsistence rules and approval processes apply as per National Financial Regulations

# 6. Grade on site (night duty) Acute Unit

CNMIII (substantive or acting) minimum grade on night duty in Acute Unit.

#### 7. Other Matters

The on-call rota including contact details/phone number (separate to duty roster) is to be made available to services and retained for record purposes.

Further review may be required as the RHA structures are embedded, including ongoing analysis of the number and nature of calls to staff on the on-call rota.
