Reporting and the collection of Monthly Absence Data

Dear Colleagues,

The purpose of this circular is to set out the arrangements in regard to the national monthly absence report for the collection and management of absence data.

Measurement of absence is critical from a national perspective as absence data is a key enabler to support effective absence management which can importantly support service delivery. The HSE **National Service Plans** set absence rates as a key performance indicator (KPI) with the objective of reducing the impact and cost of absence. The latest NSP (NSP 2022) commits to a **new national target** level of less than or equal to **4%**.

The National Absence Report is a critical health service report used both internally and externally and it is vital that all returns are received by the **19**th **of each month** so that absence levels can be reported within the timeframe required.
